
Thank You to Our Public **Television Programmers!**

Since 1990, we've partnered with APT and programmers like you to distribute more than 150 travel shows to public television. All our shows are free through APT Exchange. Together, we share a common mission to help educate and inspire Americans to broaden their perspectives through travel-and to share lots of happy travels.

Since the pandemic, we have shot and produced about ten hours of programming: a six-hour Art of Europe series, exciting programs on Iceland, Poland, France, and more.

We hope this annual Gazette helps you keep track and better understand the new programming we're excited to bring your way in the coming year. In 2025, we'll be offering Experiencing Europe (a special hour that will equip and inspire Americans to venture beyond Orlando), Symphonic Journey (a musical tour through Europe with the Cincinnati Pops), a fascinating hour on Poland, ten new episodes in Season 13 of Rick Steves' Europe, and some enticing membership specials.





COMING SOON

Rick Steves Experiencing Europe

(1 X 60 MIN, January 2025)

In this information-packed hourlong special, Rick shares lessons from a lifetime of travel. With Europe as our classroom, we'll learn smart travel skills from itinerary planning to escaping crowds and from packing light to maximizing cultural and culinary experiences.

Rick Steves Poland

(1 X 60 MIN, April 2025)

This special begins in Kraków, with its stunning square, historic castle, and nearby concentration camp memorial. Then we head to bustling Warsaw for skyscrapers and Chopin, sample gingerbread in Toruń, ogle red-brick Malbork Castle, and finish in Gdańsk with handsome Hanseatic townhouses and stirring Solidarity history.

Rick Steves' Europe: A Symphonic Journey

(1 X 60 MIN, produced by WCET, April 2025)

In this unique concert, Rick teams up with the Cincinnati Pops for a musical tour touching down in seven different European countries. With a magnificent orchestra playing stirring Romantic-era anthems, dramatic cinematography, and Rick's tour guiding giving it all context, it's a musical bon voyage for all.

Rick Steves' Europe Season 13

(10 x 30 MIN, October 2025)

Season 13 has ten new episodes—each packed with travel thrills made accessible: local culture, tasty cuisine, and lots of fun. There are two episodes on Iceland, two on Poland, "best of" episodes on Paris, Rome, London, Istanbul, and Italy, and a gourmet barge cruise through Burgundy (Rick's most decadent and hedonistic show yet).

Europe's Greatest Cities: London, Paris, Rome, and Istanbul


(4 X 60 MIN, release TBD)

Rick and his crew have long wanted to dedicate an entire hour to each of Europe's greatest cities—and that's their next big project. *Paris: The City of Light* is already shot, and next up is *London: Pomp and Traditions, Rome: The Eternal City, and Istanbul: Where East Meets West.* Look for these exciting specials as a four-part series, followed by four stand-alone hours later in 2026. This show begins in Reykjavík, side-trips to the Golden Circle's gorges, geysers, and waterfalls, and then does the 800-mile Ring Road—connecting glaciers, fjords, geothermal hotspots, and majestic Icelandic nature.
